Handicap

First and foremost, Happy Holidays and New Year. May all your shots be long and straight and your scores be lower than ever before.

During the 2018 season I will be reiterating many procedures to follow when entering, adjusting and understanding of the scores you enter during the year (Men's Club Tournament Scores are entered by the Pro-shop so league and non-tournament scores need to be addressed). Through the thoughtfulness of our Tournament Chairman (Terry Ruzzo) we have procured documentation on numerous essential Scoring requirements. These documents will posted on the bulletin board for your reference and during the year I will try to explain many of these in our Monthly Newsletters. Items that will be discussed are: Equitable Stroke Control for both 18 and 9 hole input, Competing from different USGA Course Ratings, Acceptability and unacceptability of scores entered, adjusting hole scores most likely and holes not played for handicap purposes, exceptional tournament scores and their effect on handicap index.

Lastly, sometime during the winter, we will be evaluating the viability of Gold and White Tee usage and perhaps changing the current criteria for member's usage. In addition, we will be discussing and recommending proper Blue and White Tee Course setup.
